### Please remember the following:- The student should bring

- 1. The original Fee Receipt and Identity Card (with photo). They should wear the tag-ID.
- 2. Full sets of entrance study material issued during the time of admission (Assignment module).
- 3. Assignment worked out in the entrance note book.
- 4. Big water bottle to keep drinking water from the filter before entering the class.
- 5. State Board text books (11th & 12th, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics).
- 6. NCERT text books (11th & 12th, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics).
- 7. Doubt books (200 pages note books 4 nos, which can be used to note down the doubts in Physics,
- 8. Mobile phone is banned within the institution building and compound. Perfect silence should be maintained in the class and also in the institution premises. Advance leave should be sanctioned by the hostel warden after getting the signature and the seal from institution authorities. Those who have not availed the advance leave, should meet professor in charge at the office along with hostel warden and should get permission to enter in to the class. Absentees should work out in detail the discussion paper already allotted for that day (2 times). Absentees should collect the question paper of the day of absence and after answering, submit it very next day.

#### Recommended guideline for daily time utilisation scheme

Total 24 hours  $\rightarrow$  for sleeping = 5 hours (12 midnight to 5.00 am)  $\rightarrow$  19 hours. For bath, food, travelling, refreshing, etc. = 2 hours  $\rightarrow$  17 hours. Study at the institution = 8 hours  $\rightarrow$  9 hours which should be fully utilised for study at the hostel.

#### 9 hrs work at the hostel should be focused for

- 1. Revising the theory (NCERT & STATE board) of the chapters and completing the assignment of the base material chapters allotted for the next day in the Entrance Note Book.
- 2. Prepare the assignment in the entrance note book with the help of key/hints of daily discussion paper
- 3. Sorting out of the doubts and recording it in the doubt book for doubt clarification.

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# Correspondence cum Intensive Programme - 2021 (After +1 / 11th standard) (C+IC) batch

This course is primarily a Correspondence course. This course is meant for students who can attend about 30 days class (8 hrs daily) during April & May 2020 & about 40 days class (8 hrs daily) during March, April & May in 2021. The class room coaching is free for all those who join the Correspondence cum Intensive Course. If you discontinue the Correspondence cum Intensive Course or do not attend the free class room coaching, you are not eligible for any refund.

<u>Session 1)</u> About 25 to 30 sessions each of 8 hrs, after the 11th standard (April 2020) and during this session, +1 entrance chapters will be discussed first and +2 topics will be started. There will be daily OMR Exam and 3 long Exam +1 NEET model.

**Session 2)** After the 2nd year theory examination, till 1 days before the entrance examination 2021 and during this session, 2nd year entrance chapters remaining will be discussed along with daily revision examination & OMR examinations along with model examinations (25 NEET models). There will be additional training for IIT Advanced during April-May 2021.

Student should send an email mentioning the name and roll number from their mail ID, immediately when they join for the course. This is to send question paper through email to the student. The student should answer the questions using the duplicate OMR issued, with in the specified time and after receiving the key they should evaluate the answers and should record their marks in the identity card provided.

The fee for the two year Engineering Entrance course is Rs. 47600/- and that for the Medical Entrance course is Rs. 47600/- which is to be paid at the time of admission. This fee includes cost of study materials for two years for three subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Mathematics plus Service Tax and KFC.

Note:- 1) The amount collected is Fee + GST+KFC.
